A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled "The state school aid act of 1979,"

by amending section 167 (MCL 388.1767), as amended by 2013 PA 122.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 167. (1) The department in cooperation with the
- 2 department of community health and human services shall develop
- 3 plans to assist districts and intermediate districts and local
- 4 county health departments to comply with section 1177 of the
- 5 revised school code, MCL 380.1177, and section 9209 of the public
- 6 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.9209, for each school year.

(2) Each district or intermediate district shall report to the 1 local health department in which it is located by November 1 of 2 each fiscal year, in a manner prescribed by the department of 3 community health and human services, the immunization status of 4 5 each pupil in grades K through to 12 who enrolled in the district 6 or intermediate district for the first time or , beginning in 2014-7 2015, who enrolled in grade 7 or grade 12 in the district or intermediate district for the first time, between January 1 and 8 9 September 30 of the immediately preceding fiscal year. Not later 10 than December 31 of each fiscal year, the department of community 11 health and human services shall notify the department by district or intermediate district of the percentage of entering pupils and τ 12 beginning in 2014-2015, of pupils who enrolled in grade 7 or grade 13 14 12 for the first time who do not have a completed, waived, or 15 provisional immunization record in accordance with section 1177 of 16 the revised school code, MCL 380.1177. If a district or intermediate district does not have a completed, waived, or 17 provisional immunization record in accordance with section 1177 of 18 the revised school code, MCL 380.1177, for at least 90% of the 19 20 district's or intermediate district's entering pupils, as recorded in the November 1 reports required under this subsection, the 21 district or intermediate district is subject to subsection (4) 22 until the district or intermediate district has such an 23 24 immunization record for at least 90% of its pupils who enrolled in 25 the district or intermediate district for the first time. (3) Each district or intermediate district shall again report 26 27 to the local health department in which it is located by February 1 28 of each fiscal year, in a manner prescribed by the department of 29 community health and human services, the immunization status of

- 6 fiscal year. Not later than March 31 of each fiscal year, the

- 19 subsection (4) until the district or intermediate district has such
- 20 an immunization record for at least 95% of its pupils who enrolled
- 21 in the district or intermediate district for the first time. If the
- 22 department of community health and human services is not able to
- 23 report to the department by March 31 because a district or
- 24 intermediate district fails to submit a report as required in this
- 25 subsection, or submits an incomplete, inaccurate, or late report,
- 26 the district or intermediate district is subject to subsection (4)
- 27 until the report is submitted in a complete and accurate form.

- 29 with this section, the department shall withhold 5% of the total

- 1 funds due to the district or intermediate district under this act
- 2 after the date the department of community health and human
- 3 services reports a district's or intermediate district's
- 4 noncompliance with this section to the department until the
- 5 district or intermediate district complies with this section. If
- 6 the district or intermediate district does not comply with this
- 7 section by the end of the fiscal year, the district or intermediate
- 8 district forfeits the total amount withheld.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 10 unless Senate Bill No. 981 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into
- **11** law.
