## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.11

Senator McBroom offered the following concurrent resolution: A concurrent resolution to urge the Centers for Medicare and 1 2 Medicaid Services to promptly approve a variance regarding shared 3 bathroom facilities at the D.J. Jacobetti Home for Veterans. Whereas, The D.J. Jacobetti Home for Veterans provides a home-4 like environment that meets a range of care needs, including 5 skilled nursing care. Former service members choose the D.J. 6 7 Jacobetti Home for Veterans for the unique environment it provides, which includes the comradery gained by living with other veterans. 8 9 Because this population is predominantly male, it differs 10 significantly from most skilled nursing environments; and Whereas, The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) 11 12 requires skilled nursing facilities to equip each resident room 13 with its own bathroom. If a facility wants to provide shared 14 bathrooms, CMS must approve a variance, an exemption from these

- 1 federal regulations; and
- 2 Whereas, 105 of the 186 beds at the D.J. Jacobetti Home for
- 3 Veterans, all occupied by male residents, do not meet this bathroom
- 4 requirement because they offer shared bathroom facilities. This
- 5 means they are currently ineligible to be dually certified for
- 6 Medicare and Medicaid like the other 81 beds; and
- 7 Whereas, There are times when a veteran eligible for Medicare
- 8 or Medicaid benefits seeks placement in this facility, but the only
- 9 available beds are non-certified. Veterans face the difficult
- 10 position of choosing between receiving only partial benefits to be
- 11 able to stay at the D. J. Jacobetti Home for Veterans and being
- 12 able to use all of their entitled benefits, a right they have
- 13 earned through their service to our country; and
- 14 Whereas, The advantages gained by allowing veterans to fully
- 15 utilize the health benefits available to them by approving a
- 16 variance from CMS bathroom requirements far outweigh any potential
- 17 issues. Veterans deserve to be able to live where they choose
- 18 without sacrificing any of their health benefits; now, therefore,
- **19** be it
- 20 Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives
- 21 concurring), That we urge the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid
- 22 Services to promptly approve a variance regarding shared bathroom
- 23 facilities at the D.J. Jacobetti Home for Veterans; and be it
- 24 further
- 25 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 26 Administrator of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services,
- 27 the Director of the Michigan Department of Health and Human
- 28 Services, and the Director of the Michigan Veterans Affairs Agency.
