HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.307

Reps. Wozniak, Garza, Haadsma and Sneller offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare September 2020 as PACE Awareness Month 2 in the state of Michigan.

3 Whereas, The PACE (Program of All-inclusive Care for the

4 Elderly) model centers around the belief that it is better for

5 frail, elderly individuals to be served while continuing to live

6 independently in the community whenever safely possible; and

7 Whereas, PACE is a fully integrated model that provides

8 comprehensive highly coordinated services allowing older adults who

9 meet state eligibility criteria for nursing home level of care to

10 continue living in the community; and

11 Whereas, PACE programs assume full financial risk for all

12 medical care and related services, including transportation,

- 1 hospitalization, and long-term care, in return for capitated
- 2 payments from Medicare and Medicaid. This controls costs for the
- 3 state while providing improved health outcomes and greater
- 4 satisfaction for participants; and
- 5 Whereas, Michigan's first PACE program opened in 1995. Today,
- 6 over 3,700 participants are served by 14 PACE programs in 21 sites
- 7 across the state. These locations include PACE Southeast Michigan,
- 8 Care Resources, Life Circles PACE, CentraCare, PACE of Southwest
- 9 Michigan, Huron Valley PACE, Senior CommUnity Care of Michigan,
- 10 Great Lakes PACE, Genesys PACE, Thome PACE, Community PACE at Home,
- 11 PACE Central Michigan, PACE North, and Sunrise PACE; now,
- 12 therefore, be it
- 13 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 14 this legislative body declare September 2020 as PACE Awareness
- 15 Month in the state of Michigan.
