- 3 Whereas, Brain tumors, specifically glioblastomas, have become
- 4 recognized in recent years as one of the deadliest cancers; and
- 5 Whereas, There have been an estimated 760 new diagnoses of
- 6 brain tumors in Michigan in 2019, and an estimated 600 Michigan
- 7 residents will die from a brain tumor in 2019; and
- 8 Whereas, Brain tumors can be deadly and impact the quality of
- 9 life. Brain cancer continues to be the leading cause of cancer
- 10 deaths among children and young adults; and

Whereas, In 2010, brain tumors were the highest per-patient 1 2 initial cost of care for any cancer group with an annualized cost at well over \$100,000; and 3 4 Whereas, Despite the amount of brain tumors, and their 5 devastating prognosis, there have only been four Food and Drug 6 Administration approved drugs and one device to treat brain tumors 7 in the past thirty years; now, therefore, be it 8 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative 9 body recognize May 2019 as Brain Tumor Awareness Month; and it be 10 further 11 Resolved, That Michigan has attained national recognition as a leading center of excellence in the field of brain tumor treatment 12 and research as a result of the number of patients traveling to the 13 14 state for clinical trial participation, grant dollars locally used

to create jobs, and professionals specializing in brain tumors
