Senator Hollier offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to recognize May 2019 as Brain Tumor Awareness 2 Month. 3 Whereas, Brain tumors, specifically glioblastomas, have become recognized in recent years as one of the deadliest cancers; and 4 Whereas, There have been an estimated 760 new diagnoses of 5 6 brain tumors in Michigan in 2019, and an estimated 600 Michigan 7 residents will die from a brain tumor in 2019; and 8 Whereas, Brain tumors can be deadly and impact the quality of 9 life. Brain cancer continues to be the leading cause of cancer deaths among children and young adults; and 10 Whereas, In 2010, brain tumors were the highest per-patient 11 initial cost of care for any cancer group with an annualized cost 12

- 1 at well over \$100,000; and
- 2 Whereas, Despite the amount of brain tumors, and their
- 3 devastating prognosis, there have only been four Food and Drug
- 4 Administration approved drugs and one device to treat brain tumors
- 5 in the past thirty years; now, therefore, be it
- 6 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 7 body recognize May 2019 as Brain Tumor Awareness Month; and it be
- 8 further
- 9 Resolved, That Michigan has attained national recognition as a
- 10 leading center of excellence in the field of brain tumor treatment
- 11 and research as a result of the number of patients traveling to the
- 12 state for clinical trial participation, grant dollars locally used
- 13 to create jobs, and professionals specializing in brain tumors
- 14 across the state.
