A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 48729 (MCL 324.48729), as amended by 2018 PA 643.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Outdoor Recreation.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to prohibit the sale of vapor products or alternative nicotine products that contain vitamin E acetate; and to prescribe penalties.

House Bill No. 4252, entitled

A bill to amend 1993 PA 354, entitled “Railroad code of 1993,” by amending section 315 (MCL 462.315), as amended by 2012 PA 421.

House Bill No. 4253, entitled

A bill to create a grant program to provide reimbursement of certain fitness facility membership fees, in whole or in part, to certain veterans; to create the Michigan veteran outreach fund and to provide for contributions to and expenditures from that fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities; to require the promulgation of rules; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Military, Veterans and Homeland Security.

House Bill No. 4254, entitled

A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled "Corrections code of 1953," by amending the title and section 62 (MCL 791.262), the title as amended by 2006 PA 172 and section 62 as amended by 1987 PA 251.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Reps. Brann and Steven Johnson introduced

House Bill No. 4255, entitled

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," (MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 706.

The bill was read a first time by its title and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

House Bill No. 4256, entitled

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," by amending section 502c (MCL 750.502c), as amended by 2015 PA 144.

A bill to clarify certain powers of the governor; and to impose certain duties on certain state officials.
