Senate Bill 1203 (as reported without amendment)

Sponsor: Senator Curtis Hertel Committee: Appropriations

CONTENT

This bill would amend the Limousine, Taxicab, and Transportation Network Company Act to extend a sunset date, from March 21, 2023, to September 30, 2027. The extension would maintain the variable renewal fees established under Public Act 345 of 2016, which eliminated the flat \$50 fee that existed previously. The variable fees increase according to the number of vehicles being registered by an applicant according to the schedule below.

| Number of Vehicles Registered | Fee |
|-------------------------------|----------|
| 10 | \$550 |
| 11-25 | \$1,000 |
| 26-100 | \$2,500 |
| 101-500 | \$5,000 |
| 501-1,000 | \$10,000 |
| More than 1,000 | \$30,000 |

FISCAL IMPACT

This bill would have a positive fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. Extending the sunset for these fees is expected to result in a \$281,400 increase in revenue for the Department. If the bill were not enacted, the fee would revert to the \$50 flat rate, and the Department would not see this increased revenue.
