23 MICHIGAN NATURAL RESOURCES TRUST FUND

24 Sec. 301. (1) The department of natural resources shall enter 25 into agreements with local units of government to administer the 26 grants identified in part 1. Among other provisions, the agreements 27 must require that grant recipients agree to dedicate to public outdoor recreation uses in perpetuity the land acquired or 28 29 developed; to replace lands converted or lost to other than public

outdoor recreation use; and, for parcels acquired that are larger than 5 acres, to provide this state with a nonparticipating 1/6 minimum royalty interest in any acquired minerals that are retained by the grant recipient.

5 (2) The agreements under subsection (1) must also provide that
6 the full payments of grants be made only after proof of
7 acquisition, or proof of completion of the development project, is
8 submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are verified by the
9 department of natural resources. This requirement may be waived by
10 the department of natural resources.

Sec. 302. The appropriations in part 1 for capital outlay carry forward at the end of the fiscal year, consistent with section 248 of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1248.

Sec. 303.
