- 6 (b) Receives a COVID-19 diagnosis from a physician.
- 7 (c) Receives a presumptive positive COVID-19 test.
- 8 (d) Receives a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis.
- 9 (2) As used in this section:
- 10 (a) "COVID-19" means the novel coronavirus identified as SARS-
