

# HOUSE BILL NO. 6510

November 29, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Filler, Sabo, Rogers, Griffin, LaGrand, Hood, Weiss, Harris, O'Neal, Brixie, Rabhi, Koleszar, Puri, Glanville, Neeley, Brenda Carter, Aiyash, Yaroch, Bezotte, Mekoski and Breen and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled  
"The state school aid act of 1979,"  
by amending section 11 (MCL 388.1611), as amended by 2022 PA 212,  
and by adding section 97g.

## **THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 11. (1) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023,  
2 there is appropriated for the public schools of this state and  
3 certain other state purposes relating to education the sum of  
4 ~~\$16,754,072,900.00~~ **\$16,754,073,000.00** from the state school aid

1 fund, the sum of \$124,200,000.00 from the general fund, an amount  
2 not to exceed \$72,000,000.00 from the community district education  
3 trust fund created under section 12 of the Michigan trust fund act,  
4 2000 PA 489, MCL 12.262, and an amount not to exceed  
5 \$140,400,000.00 from the MPSEERS retirement obligation reform  
6 reserve fund created under section 147b. In addition, all available  
7 federal funds are only appropriated as allocated in this article  
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023.

9 (2) The appropriations under this section are allocated as  
10 provided in this article. Money appropriated under this section  
11 from the general fund must be expended to fund the purposes of this  
12 article before the expenditure of money appropriated under this  
13 section from the state school aid fund.

14 (3) Any general fund allocations under this article that are  
15 not expended by the end of the fiscal year are transferred to the  
16 school aid stabilization fund created under section 11a.

17 **Sec. 97g. (1) From the state school aid fund money**  
18 **appropriated in section 11, there is allocated an amount not to**  
19 **exceed \$100.00 for 2022-2023 to districts as prescribed in this**  
20 **section.**

21 (2) To receive funding under this section, a district must  
22 apply for the funding in a form and manner prescribed by the  
23 department.

24 (3) From the money allocated under this section, the  
25 department shall pay each district that has applied for funding as  
26 described in subsection (2) for the development and implementation  
27 of a numbering system as required under section 1e of 1937 PA 306,  
28 MCL 388.851e, which includes, but is not limited to, the purchasing  
29 of materials and payment to staff or workers as related to the

1 numbering system described in this subsection.

2 (4) Notwithstanding section 17b, the department shall make  
3 payments under this section on a schedule determined by the  
4 department.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
6 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 6509 (request no.  
7 06795'22) of the 101st Legislature is enacted into law.
