

SENATE BILL NO. 302

March 24, 2021, Introduced by Senators LASATA, BUMSTEAD, HORN, THEIS, STAMAS, ZORN, BARRETT, DALEY, OUTMAN and VANDERWALL and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 495 (MCL 168.495), as amended by 2018 PA 603.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 495. The registration application must contain all of the
2 following:

3 (a) The name of the elector.

4 (b) The residence address of the elector, including the street
5 and number or rural route and box number and the apartment number,

1 if any.

2 (c) The city or township and county of residence of the
3 elector.

4 (d) The date of birth of the elector.

5 (e) The driver license or state personal identification card
6 number of the elector, if available.

7 (f) A statement that the elector is a citizen of the United
8 States.

9 (g) A statement that the elector is at the time of completing
10 the affidavit, or will be on the date of the next election, not
11 less than 18 years of age.

12 (h) A statement that the elector has or will have lived in
13 this state not less than 30 days before the next election.

14 (i) A statement that the elector has or will have established
15 his or her residence in the township or city in which the elector
16 is applying for registration not less than 30 days before the next
17 election.

18 (j) A statement that the elector is or will be a qualified
19 elector of the township or city on the date of the next election.

20 (k) A space in which the elector shall state the place of the
21 elector's last registration, if any.

22 (l) A statement that the registration is not effective until
23 processed by the clerk of the city or township in which the
24 applicant resides.

25 (m) A statement that the applicant, if qualified, may vote at
26 an election occurring on or after the date of completing the
27 application.

28 (n) A statement authorizing the cancellation of registration
29 at the elector's last place of registration.

1 **(o) A statement that the elector does not claim voting**
2 **residence or the right to vote in another state or territory.**

3 **(p)** ~~(e)~~—A space for the elector to sign and certify to the
4 truth of the statements on the application.
