15 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022 is \$0.00 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent

resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

- Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for Northern Michigan tourism and sports fund, \$30,000,000.00 is designated as a work project appropriation for a grant program for infrastructure and events supporting Michigan recreation, sports, and tourism. Not less than 50% annually shall be spent on grants awarded to Upper Peninsula projects. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds allocated pursuant to this section shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for expenditure for projects under this section until the projects have been completed. The following is in compliance with section 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:
- (a) The purpose of the work project is to support Michigan recreation, sports, and tourism.
- (b) The work project will be accomplished by grants for infrastructure and events supporting Michigan recreation, sports, and tourism.
- (c) The total estimated cost of the work project is \$30,000,000.00.
