by President Dwight D. Eisenhower and enacted into law on June 4,
 1958, as Public Law 85-445; and

3 Whereas, This state is fortunate to celebrate our Great Lakes
4 and the fantastic diversity of water-based recreation we enjoy

6 Whereas, During the week from May 21 to May 27, this state's
7 boating community celebrates Boating Safety Week through a campaign
8 that aims to increase awareness of boating safety practices by
9 collaborating with partners to share local community events,
10 through social media, workshops, and more; and

11 Whereas, Boating Safety Week is the period of time in North 12 America when people recognize the vital importance of highlighting 13 safe boating practices; now, therefore, be it

14 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 15 this legislative body declare May 21-May 27, 2022, as Boating 16 Safety Week in the state of Michigan. We recognize and celebrate 17 the importance of teaching safe boating.
