A resolution to support President Joe Biden's efforts to

Whereas, On February 24, President Joe Biden signed an

executive order to strengthen U.S. supply chains. The order is

targeted at strengthening supply chains for advanced batteries,

7 pharmaceuticals, critical minerals, and semiconductors. The

8 President also ordered a review of supply chains for defense,

9 public health and biological preparedness, information

10 communications technology, energy, transportation, and food

production; and

12 Whereas, The United States has become increasingly reliant on

- 1 imported goods, sometimes leading to disastrous consequences.
- 2 During the COVID-19 Pandemic, a failure of medical supply chains
- 3 led to shortages of personal protective equipment and other
- 4 supplies throughout the country; and
- 5 Whereas, The failure of U.S. supply chains has had a direct
- 6 negative impact on Michigan residents. Issues with the
- 7 semiconductor supply chain has caused issues for the automobile
- 8 industry, including layoffs of 160 employees at the General Motors'
- 9 Engine Operations Plant in Flint; and
- 10 Whereas, Strengthening U.S. supply chains will strengthen the
- 11 American economy and protect national security. Bringing
- 12 manufacturers to the United States will create high-paying jobs and
- 13 ensure the ability to produce goods that are vital to our national
- 14 defense; now, therefore, be it
- 15 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we support
- 16 President Joe Biden's efforts to strengthen U.S. supply chains and
- 17 urge continued action to address the semiconductor shortage; and be
