

SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 4613

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled  
"Public health code,"  
by amending section 20952 (MCL 333.20952), as amended by 2024 PA  
48.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 20952. (1) The department may grant a nonrenewable  
2 temporary license to an individual who has made proper application  
3 with the required fee for licensure as a medical first responder,  
4 emergency medical technician, emergency medical technician  
5 specialist, or paramedic and who has successfully completed all of  
6 the requirements for licensure except for the examinations  
7 described in section 20950. A temporary license is valid for ~~120~~  
8 ~~days~~ **1 year** from the date of an accepted application.

1           (2) An individual holding a temporary license ~~as an emergency~~  
2 ~~medical technician~~ **under this section** shall practice only under the  
3 direct supervision ~~of an emergency medical technician, emergency~~  
4 ~~medical technician specialist, or paramedic who holds a license~~  
5 ~~other than a temporary license.~~

6           ~~(3) An individual holding a temporary license as an emergency~~  
7 ~~medical technician specialist shall practice only under the direct~~  
8 ~~supervision of an emergency medical technician specialist or~~  
9 ~~paramedic who holds a license other than a temporary license.~~

10           ~~(4) An individual holding a temporary license as a paramedic~~  
11 ~~shall practice only under the direct supervision of a paramedic who~~  
12 ~~holds a license other than a temporary license.~~ **as provided under**  
13 **section 20952a.**

14           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
15 unless House Bill No. 4614 of the 102nd Legislature is enacted into  
16 law.
