A bill to designate Lunar New Year as a holiday in this state.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. The legislature declares that the second new moon
2 after the winter solstice or the third new moon after the winter
3 solstice if an intercalary month intervenes, according to the
4 Chinese calendar, shall be known as "Lunar New Year", a holiday
5 celebrated by Michiganders of Chinese, Korean, Taiwanese,
6 Vietnamese, and other East or Southeast Asian origins.
