## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1170a. (1) By not later than the 2017-2018 school year,

- 6 incorporated into the instruction described in this subdivision
- 7 through the provision of hands-on training. The instruction
- 8 described in this subdivision must be based on either of the
- 9 following:
- (i) An instructional program developed by the American Red
- 11 Cross or the American Heart Association.
- 12 (ii) Nationally recognized, evidence-based guidelines for
- 13 cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
- 14 (b) Instruction about automated external defibrillators for
- 15 pupils enrolled in grades 7 to 12.
- 16 (c) Instruction for pupils enrolled in grades 7 to 12 that is
- 17 developed by the Stop the Bleed program or the American College of
- 18 Surgeons Committee on Trauma or determined appropriate by the
- 19 department concerning the use of first aid response kits. For
- 20 pupils who are able to physically participate, the instruction
- 21 described in this subdivision is strongly encouraged to be through
- 22 the provision of hands-on training. The first aid response kits
- 23 described in this subdivision must be kits that contain at least
- 24 all of the following:
- 25 (i) A tourniquet.
- 26 (ii) Bleeding control dressings.
- 27 (iii) Compression bandages.
- 28 (iv) Latex-free protective gloves.
- 29 (v) Trauma shears.

- 2  $(v\ddot{u})$  A copy of instructions on the use of the kit described in 3 this subdivision.
- 4 (2) The content standards or <del>subject area content expectations</del>
- 5 and guidelines under subsection (1) shall must not require a
- 6 certificated teacher to be an authorized CPR/AED instructor to
- 7 facilitate, provide, or oversee instruction described in subsection
- 8 (1)(a) if that instruction does not result in a pupil earning a CPR
- 9 certification card or status.
- 10 (3) If instruction described in subsection (1)(a) will result
- 11 in a pupil earning a CPR certification card or status, that
- 12 instruction must be taught by an authorized CPR/AED instructor, as

- 14 (4) School districts, public school academies, and nonpublic
- 15 schools are encouraged to use locally available resources to
- 16 provide the instruction required to meet the content standards or
- 17 subject area content expectations and guidelines under subsection
- 18 (1), including, but not limited to, emergency any of the following:
- 19 (a) Emergency medical technicians. , paramedics, police
- 20 (b) Paramedics.
- 21 (c) Police officers. , firefighters, representatives
- 22 (d) Firefighters.
- 23 (e) Licensed registered professional nurses, including school
- 24 nurses.
- 25 (f) Representatives of the American Heart Association or
- 26 American Red Cross. , or properly
- 27 (g) Properly trained teachers or other school employees who
- 28 are trained as Stop the Bleed instructors.

- 6 (a) "Authorized CPR/AED instructor" means an instructor who is 7 authorized by the American Heart Association, American Red Cross, 8 or a similar nationally recognized association to provide 9 instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation that results in the 10 issuance of a CPR certification card or status.
- 11 (b) "CPR certification card or status" means a card or other
  12 credential evidencing successful completion of instruction in
  13 cardiopulmonary resuscitation that is issued by the American Heart
  14 Association, American Red Cross, or a similar nationally recognized
  15 organization using evidence-based guidelines for the teaching of
  16 cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
