

HOUSE BILL NO. 4324

March 22, 2023, Introduced by Reps. DeSana, Alexander, Fox, DeBoyer, Maddock, Bezotte, Hoadley and Friske and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
"Michigan election law,"
by amending section 2 (MCL 168.2), as amended by 2018 PA 603.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Absent voter" is a voter who utilizes the process
3 described in section 759.

4 (b) "Absent voter ballot" means a ballot that is issued to a
5 voter through the absentee voter process.

6 (c) "Ballot container" is defined in section 14a.

1 (d) "Business day" or "secular day" means a day that is not a
2 Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.

3 (e) "Clearly observable boundaries" is defined in section
4 654a.

5 (f) "Common carrier" means a company that transports mail, on
6 reasonable request, on regular routes and at set rates.

7 (g) "Election" means an election or primary election at which
8 the electors of this state or of a subdivision of this state choose
9 or nominate by ballot an individual for public office or decide a
10 ballot question lawfully submitted to them.

11 (h) "Election precinct" is defined in section 654.

12 (i) "Fall" state and county conventions and "spring" state and
13 county conventions are assigned meanings in section 596.

14 (j) "General election" or "general November election" means
15 the election held on the November regular election date in an even
16 numbered year.

17 (k) "Identification for election purposes" means, if issued to
18 the individual presenting the card or document and if presented for
19 voting purposes the name on the card or document sufficiently
20 matches the individual's name in ~~his or her~~ **the individual's** voter
21 registration record so as to accurately identify the individual as
22 the registered elector, or if issued to the individual presenting
23 the card or document and if presented for voter registration
24 purposes, any of the following:

25 (i) An operator's or chauffeur's license issued under the
26 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, or an
27 enhanced driver license issued under the enhanced driver license
28 and enhanced official state personal identification card act, 2008
29 PA 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308.

1 (ii) An official state personal identification card issued
2 under 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.291 to 28.300, or an enhanced official
3 state personal identification card issued under the enhanced driver
4 license and enhanced official state personal identification card
5 act, 2008 PA 23, MCL 28.301 to 28.308.

6 (iii) A current operator's or chauffeur's license issued by
7 another state.

8 (iv) A current state personal identification card issued by
9 another state.

10 (v) A current state government issued photo identification
11 card.

12 (vi) A current United States passport or federal government
13 issued photo identification card.

14 (vii) A current military photo identification card.

15 (viii) A current tribal photo identification card.

16 (ix) A current student photo identification card issued by a
17 high school in this state, an institution of higher education in
18 this state described in section 4, 5, or 6 of article VIII of the
19 state constitution of 1963, a junior college or community college
20 established under section 7 of article VIII of the state
21 constitution of 1963, or another accredited degree or certificate
22 granting college or university, junior college, or community
23 college located in this state.

24 (x) **A current concealed pistol license issued under 1927 PA**
25 **372, MCL 28.421 to 28.435.**

26 (l) "Immediate family" means an individual's father, mother,
27 son, daughter, brother, sister, and spouse and a relative of any
28 degree residing in the same household as that individual.
