April 25, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Aiyash, Breen, Byrnes, Brabec, Churches, Paiz, Glanville, Young, O'Neal, MacDonell, Hood, Rheingans, Stone, Puri and Brixie and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to designate Eid al-Adha and Eid al-Fitr as holidays in this state.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. The legislature declares that the tenth day of the
2 month of Dhul Hijjah, according to the Islamic Hijri calendar,
3 shall be known as "Eid al-Adha".

4 Sec. 2. The legislature declares that the first day of the
5 month of Shawwal, according to the Islamic Hijri calendar, shall be
6 known as "Eid al-Fitr".
