A bill to amend 2019 PA 39, entitled
"Administration of opioid antagonists act,"
by amending section 105 (MCL 15.675).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 105. **(1)** An employee or agent may possess an opioid
2 antagonist distributed to that employee or agent under section 103
3 and may administer that opioid antagonist to an individual if both
4 of the following apply:
5 (a) The employee or agent has been trained in the proper

1 administration of that opioid antagonist.

2 (b) The employee or agent has reason to believe that the
3 individual is experiencing an opioid-related overdose.

4 **(2) Subject to appropriation of sufficient funding, a local**
5 **health department shall provide an employee or agent of an agency**
6 **that is a school district with the training required under**
7 **subsection (1).**
