

HOUSE BILL NO. 5039

September 26, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Tsernoglou, Aragona, Paiz, McFall, Breen, Roth, Wozniak, McKinney, Andrews, Price, Hope, Wegela, Rheingans, Tyrone Carter, Weiss and Young and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to prohibit counties from enacting or enforcing an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule that regulates a dog based on the breed or perceived breed of the dog; and to provide for the powers and duties of counties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. A county shall not enact or enforce an ordinance,
2 policy, resolution, or rule that regulates a dog based on breed or
3 perceived breed. However, this act does not prohibit a county from
4 enacting an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule that places

1 restrictions or imposes additional requirements on dogs or dog
2 owners.

3 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
4 date it is enacted into law.
