THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 20925. (1) This part does not prohibit an ambulance from
- 2 providing emergency transport of a police dog that is injured in
- 3 the line of duty or a retired police dog to a veterinary clinic or
- 4 similar facility, if the police dog or retired police dog is in
- 5 need of emergency medical treatment and there are no individuals
- 6 who require transport or emergency assistance at that time.

- 1 Ambulance personnel may require that a police officer accompany the
 2 police dog or retired police dog during the emergency transport.

- 4 (a) "Police dog" means that term as defined in section 50c of 5 the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.50c.
 - (b) "Retired police dog" means a dog that is trained for law enforcement work and that was used by a law enforcement agency of this state or of a local unit of government of this state until the dog ceased to work due to age or disease.
