

HOUSE BILL NO. 5113

October 10, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Young, Brabec, Haadsma, O'Neal, Hood, Dievendorf, Steckloff, Weiss, Byrnes, Miller, Hope, Tyrone Carter, Paiz, Liberati, Coleman, McFall, Neeley, Rheingans, McKinney, Aiyash and Whitsett and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21525.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 21525. (1) If a hospital conducts a drug screen to assist
2 in diagnosing a patient's condition, the hospital shall include a
3 test for fentanyl in that drug screen.

4 (2) If a drug screen under subsection (1) detects fentanyl,
5 the hospital shall report the test result to the department of

1 health and human services in the form and manner prescribed by the
2 department of health and human services. The report of information
3 under this section must not include an identifier that would make
4 it possible to identify the individual to whom the drug screen
5 pertains.

6 (3) As used in this section, "drug screen" means a chemical
7 analysis intended to test a patient for the presence of multiple
8 drugs, including, but not limited to, cocaine, opioids, and
9 phencyclidine.
