

# HOUSE BILL NO. 5153

October 17, 2023, Introduced by Reps. Kuhn, Steele, Tisdel, Schmaltz, Hall and VanWoerkom and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 224g.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 224g. (1) A person shall not possess, use, transport,  
2 purchase, carry, ship, receive, or distribute a firearm or  
3 ammunition in this state if that person is prohibited under 18 USC  
4 922(g) (9) from shipping or transporting in interstate or foreign  
5 commerce, or possessing in or affecting commerce, any firearm or  
6 ammunition, or receiving any firearm or ammunition which has been

1 shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce.

2 (2) A person who possesses, uses, transports, purchases,  
3 carries, ships, receives, or distributes a firearm or ammunition in  
4 this state in violation of this section is guilty of a felony  
5 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of  
6 not more than \$5,000.00, or both.

7 (3) Any single criminal transaction where a person possesses,  
8 uses, transports, sells, carries, ships, or distributes ammunition  
9 in violation of this section, regardless of the amount of  
10 ammunition involved, constitutes 1 offense.

11 (4) As used in this section, "ammunition" means any projectile  
12 that, in its current state, may be expelled from a firearm by an  
13 explosive.
