

SENATE BILL NO. 114

March 01, 2023, Introduced by Senators THEIS, ALBERT, RUNESTAD, OUTMAN, BELLINO, DALEY, MCBROOM, DAMOOSE, VICTORY, LAUWERS and LINDSEY and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 2013 PA 182, entitled
"Abortion Insurance Opt-Out Act,"
by amending section 10 (MCL 550.550).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 10. (1) An individual or a health facility or agency
2 shall not seek or accept reimbursement from a qualified health
3 plan; an expense-incurred hospital, medical, or surgical policy or
4 certificate; a health maintenance organization group or individual
5 contract; or a health care corporation group or nongroup
6 certificate for any services provided that are directly related to

1 the performance of an elective abortion unless the reimbursement
2 sought or accepted is from an optional rider provided under this
3 act.

4 (2) This section does not affect legitimate and routine
5 obstetric care, diagnostic testing, or other nonabortion
6 procedures.

7 (3) An individual or health facility or agency that violates
8 this section is liable for a civil fine of up to ~~\$10,000.00~~
9 **\$25,000.00** per violation. The department shall investigate an
10 alleged violation of this section, and the attorney general, in
11 cooperation with the department, may bring an action to enforce
12 this section.

13 (4) This section does not restrict the right of a physician or
14 other individual licensed or registered under the public health
15 code, **1978 PA 368, MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211**, to discuss abortion
16 or abortion services with a patient who is pregnant.
