

SENATE BILL NO. 621

October 26, 2023, Introduced by Senators MCBROOM, HOITENGA, BELLINO and LINDSEY and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 13k (MCL 777.13k), as amended by 2018 PA 587.
