THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 4 \$1,000.00 for each violation:
- 5 (a) The time, place, or manner of an election.
- 6 (b) The qualifications for or restrictions on voter

- 2 (c) Criminal penalties associated with voting in an election.
- 3 (d) An individual's voter registration status or eligibility.
- 4 (2) An individual intentionally makes a false statement or
- 5 misrepresentation under subsection (1) if the individual knows the
- 6 statement or misrepresentation is false and makes the false
- 7 statement or misrepresentation with the intent to impede or prevent
- 8 another individual from exercising the individual's right to vote
- 9 in an election.
- 10 (3) An entity that employs, for an election-related purpose,
- 11 an individual who violates this section is subject to a civil fine
- 12 of not more than \$10,000.00.
