The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute to express our condolences for the 2 tragic shooting at Michigan State University.

Whereas, In the evening hours of February 13, 2023, the

4 students, staff, and community members within and surrounding

Michigan State University, mere miles from this Chamber, sufferedan unspeakable tragedy. A lone gunman entered campus buildings and

7 opened fire on those inside, beginning an hours-long effort by

 $oldsymbol{8}$ first responders to protect those on campus and bring an end to the

9 violence. Those in and around campus were ordered to shelter in

10 place by police, forced to simply wait and hope that the ongoing

11 nightmare unfolding within their community would eventually come to

12 an end without more bloodshed. Throughout the country, the friends

- 1 and family members of those in the community looked on in horror.
- 2 The gunman was eventually found, but not before he had taken the
- 3 lives of three students and injured even more. We in this Chamber,
- 4 like all those with ties to Michigan State University across the
- 5 nation, mourn this senseless, unnecessary loss of life and pray
- 6 that those still hospitalized will recover; and
- 7 Whereas, Acts of mass violence like this tragedy reflect an
- 8 utter rejection of the value and dignity that should be afforded to
- 9 every single human being. What is left in the wake of a life taken
- 10 in such a violent, chaotic manner is a sense of confusion,
- 11 frustration, and anguish that is impossible to put into words.
- 12 Tragedies like this leave communities forever scarred and hearts
- 13 forever broken; and
- 14 Whereas, Now more than ever, it is important to recognize the
- 15 heroism and resolve demonstrated by those who lead us through times
- 16 of tragedy. To those on the police force who worked tirelessly to
- 17 defend the community they are entrusted to protect and who bravely
- 18 entered building after building, classroom after classroom we see
- 19 you, and we thank you. To the medical professionals who responded
- 20 on scene and to those still caring for the individuals who have
- 21 suffered injury we see you, and we thank you. To the heroic staff
- 22 and students of Michigan State University who risked their own
- 23 lives to ensure the safety of those around them we see you, and
- 24 we thank you. It should not take a tragedy for us to recognize the
- 25 best of us, but we would do a dishonor to their courage if we did
- 26 not take this opportunity to commend their valiant efforts and
- 27 express our gratitude on behalf of Michiganders everywhere; and
