

## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 18

Senator Camilleri offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to recognize March 5-11, 2023, as School Social  
2 Work Week.

3 Whereas, School social workers serve as vital members of the  
4 education team, playing a central role in creating a positive  
5 environment in schools; and

6 Whereas, Social workers in schools are exceptionally skilled  
7 in providing services to students who face serious challenges to  
8 school success including disability, poverty, discrimination,  
9 abuse, neglect, mental illness, homelessness, bullying, familial  
10 stressors, and other barriers to learning; and

11 Whereas, School-based mental health programs are critical to  
12 the early identification and intervention of mental health problems

1 by providing the appropriate services; and

2       Whereas, School social workers, who are licensed mental health  
3 professionals in the United States, provide the necessary  
4 assessment, interventions, counseling, family outreach, community  
5 referrals, and also maintain knowledge of school culture and  
6 climate, which are all necessary for responsible school safety  
7 planning; and

8       Whereas, Research indicates that school-based mental health  
9 programs led by school social workers improve educational outcomes  
10 by decreasing absences, dropout rates, and discipline referrals,  
11 while also improving academic achievement; and

12       Whereas, Social workers in schools play a pivotal role in  
13 creating partnerships between the home, school, and community to  
14 ensure academic success; and

15       Whereas, School districts and local educational agencies  
16 should continue to work with school social workers to address  
17 students' social, emotional, physical, mental health, and  
18 environmental needs so that students can succeed; and

19       Whereas, The celebration of School Social Work Week on March  
20 5-11, 2023 highlights the important role school social workers play  
21 in the lives of students in Michigan; now, therefore, be it

22       Resolved, That the members of this legislative body recognize  
23 March 5-11, 2023, as School Social Work Week; and be it further

24       Resolved, That we honor and recognize the contributions of  
25 school social workers to the successes of students; and be it  
26 further

27       Resolved, That we encourage the people of Michigan to observe  
28 School Social Work Week with appropriate ceremonies and activities  
29 to promote awareness about the vital role of school social workers,
