

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 73

Senators Bayer, Cherry, Geiss, McMorrow, Moss, Polehanki and Wojno offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to designate September 2023 as Suicide Prevention
2 Month.

3 Whereas, There is no single cause or solution to suicide, but
4 we know that access to support and treatment saves lives; and

5 Whereas, Mental health can be a common factor for those
6 contemplating suicide, and other contributing factors play a large
7 role; and

8 Whereas, According to the Centers for Disease Control and
9 Prevention, suicide is the tenth leading cause of death in the
10 United States as well as the second leading cause of death among
11 individuals between the ages of 10 and 34 years; and

1 Whereas, In the United States, an individual dies by suicide
2 every 11 minutes, resulting in nearly 48,000 deaths each year; and

3 Whereas, Over 12 million adults reported seriously considering
4 suicide and 1.7 million people have attempted suicide; and

5 Whereas, The stigma associated with mental health conditions
6 and suicidality hinders suicide prevention by discouraging at-risk
7 individuals from seeking lifesaving help and can further traumatize
8 survivors of suicide loss and individuals with lived experience of
9 suicide; and

10 Whereas, Despite mental health playing a factor in suicide
11 prevention, many Americans continue to struggle to find treatment
12 as a result of expense or inaccessibility; and

13 Whereas, We recognize that suicide and suicide attempts affect
14 the friends and loved ones of those around us; and

15 Whereas, Those experiencing suicidal thoughts or mental
16 distress can call or text 988 to speak with someone free and
17 confidentially; and

18 Whereas, We must continue to invest in mental health resources
19 and address the stigma of ideation of suicide to ensure no one
20 feels that they do not have someone to speak to when they need it;
21 now, therefore, be it

22 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
23 body designate September 2023 as Suicide Prevention Month.
