- 3 live their best lives, one that all Americans and Michiganians
- 4 should support; and
- 5 Whereas, Since 1946, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society
- 6 has been a driving force of MS research, relentlessly pursuing
- 7 prevention, treatments, and a cure, and has invested more than \$1
- 8 billion in groundbreaking research; and
- 9 Whereas, Funds raised through the National Multiple Sclerosis
- 10 Society fuels research on pathways to MS cures and invests in the
- 11 MS research workforce at the best medical centers, universities,
- 12 and other institutions throughout the U.S. and abroad, leading to
- 13 many breakthroughs in the treatment of MS; and
- 14 Whereas, Together we have transformed what it means to live
- 15 with MS and provided global leadership to help achieve our vision
- 16 of a world free of MS; and
- 17 Whereas, The state of Michigan recognizes the importance of
- 18 finding the cause and cure of MS and expresses its appreciation for
- 19 the dedication that the Michigan Chapter of the National Multiple
- 20 Sclerosis Society has shown toward creating a world free of MS;
- 21 now, therefore, be it
- 22 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 23 body recognize March 12-18, 2023, as Multiple Sclerosis (MS) Week;
- 24 and be it further
- 25 Resolved, That we commend this observance for all Michiganians
- 26 and encourage citizens to learn more about MS and what they can do
- 27 to support individuals with MS and their families.
