HOUSE BILL NO. 4284

March 20, 2025, Introduced by Reps. Paquette, Wozniak, Cavitt, Maddock, Carra, Schuette and Wilson and referred to Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms and electro-muscular disruption devices under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts

and parts of acts inconsistent with this act," by amending section 5l (MCL 28.425l), as amended by 2017 PA 95.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5l. (1) A license to carry a concealed pistol, including a renewal license, is valid until the applicant's date of birth that 2 3 falls not less than 4 years or more than 5 years after the license 4 is issued or renewed, as applicable. The county clerk shall notify 5 the licensee that his or her the licensee's license is about to expire and may be renewed as provided in this section. The 6 7 notification must be sent by the county clerk to the last known 8 address of the licensee as shown on the records of the county 9 clerk. The notification must be sent in a sealed envelope by first-10 class mail not less than 3 months or more than 6 months before the expiration date of the current license. Except as provided in this 11 12 section, a renewal of a license under section 5b must be issued in 13 the same manner as an original license issued under section 5b. An 14 applicant is eligible for a renewal of a license under this section 15 if his or her the applicant's license is not expired, or expired 16 within a 1-year period before the date of application under this 17 section. Each applicant who submits an application for a renewal 18 license to a county clerk under this section shall pay an 19 application and licensing fee of \$115.00 \$30.00 by any method of 20 payment accepted by that county for payments of other fees and 21 penalties. No other charge, fee, cost, or assessment, including any 22 local charge, fee, cost, or assessment, is required of the 23 applicant except as specifically authorized in this act. The 24 applicant shall pay the application and licensing fee to the 25 county. The county treasurer shall deposit \$36.00 of each the fee 26 collected under this subsection in the concealed pistol licensing

fund of that county created in section 5x. The county treasurer 1 2 shall forward the balance remaining to the state treasurer. The state treasurer shall deposit the balance of the fee in the general 3 fund to the credit of the department of state police. 4 5 (2) Subject to subsections (9) (8) and (10), (9), an 6 application to renew a license to carry a concealed pistol may be 7 submitted not more than 6 months before the expiration of the current license. No later than December 1, 2018, the The department 8 9 of state police shall provide a system for an applicant to submit 10 his or her the applicant's application to renew a license to carry 11 a concealed pistol online or by first-class mail and shall accept 12 those applications on behalf of the county clerk as required under 13 this act. at no additional charge. Each applicant who submits a 14 renewal license online or by first-class mail to the department of 15 state police under this section shall pay an application and 16 licensing fee of \$115.00 \$30.00 by any method of payment accepted 17 by the department of state police. No other charge, fee, cost, or assessment is required of the applicant except as specifically 18 19 authorized in this act. The applicant shall pay the application and 20 licensing fee to the this state. The state treasurer shall forward 21 \$36.00 of each the fee collected under this subsection to the county treasurer who shall deposit the \$36.00 fee in the concealed 22 23 pistol licensing fund of that county created in section 5x. The 24 state treasurer shall deposit the balance of the fee in the general 25 fund to the credit of the department of state police. The 26 department of state police shall notify the county clerk of the 27 county in which the applicant resides of a properly submitted online application or application by first-class mail received by 28 29 the department. If the county clerk issues a renewal license under

- 21 state police shall mail an applicant a receipt by first-class mail
- 22 for his or her the applicant's renewal application submitted by
- 23 first-class mail at the time the application is received by the
- 24 department of state police. The receipt issued under this
- 25 subsection to an individual applying for a renewal license whose
- 26 current license is not expired at the time of application must
- 27 contain all of the following:
- 28 (a) The name of the applicant.
- 29 (b) The date and time the receipt is issued.

- 2 (d) The applicant's state-issued driver license or personal3 identification card number.
- 4 (e) The statement "This receipt was issued for the purpose of renewal of a concealed pistol license. As provided in section 5*l* of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.425*l*, this receipt shall serve as a concealed pistol license for the individual named in the receipt when carried with the expired license and is valid until a license or notice of statutory disqualification is issued by the county clerk. This receipt does not exempt the individual named in the receipt from

complying with all applicable laws for the purchase of firearms.".

- 14 (g) An impression of the county seal, if applicable.
- 15 (4) The receipt issued under subsection (3) to an individual
 16 applying for a renewal license whose license is expired must
 17 contain all of the following:
- 18 (a) The name of the applicant.
- 19 (b) The date and time the receipt is issued.
- 20 (c) The amount paid.
- (d) The applicant's state-issued driver license or personalidentification card number.
- (e) The statement "This receipt was issued for the purpose of renewal of a concealed pistol license. As provided in section 5l of 1927 PA 372, MCL 28.425l, if a license or notice of statutory disqualification is not issued within 30 days after the date this receipt was issued, this receipt shall serve as a concealed pistol license for the individual named in the receipt when carried with an official state-issued driver license or personal identification

card. The receipt is valid as a license until a license or a notice 1 2 of statutory disqualification is issued by the county clerk. This receipt does not exempt the individual named in the receipt from 3 4 complying with all applicable laws for the purchase of firearms.". (5) Until November 30, 2018, a member of the United States 5 6 Armed Forces, the United States Armed Forces Reserve, or the 7 Michigan National Guard who is on orders to a duty station outside 8 of this state may submit his or her application to renew a license 9 to carry a concealed pistol by first-class mail, containing the 10 required fee, a notarized application, the licensee's address of 11 record within the state, the licensee's orders to report to a duty 12 station outside of this state, and if the licensee desires to have 13 his or her application receipt, renewal license, or any other 14 notices mailed to his or her address of assignment or deployment, a 15 letter requesting that action including the address of assignment 16 or deployment. If the county clerk issues a renewal license under 17 this section, the county clerk shall send the license to the licensee by first-class mail in a sealed envelope. If the licensee 18 19 is a member of the United States Armed Forces, the United States 20 Armed Forces Reserve, or the Michigan National Guard who is on 21 orders to a duty station outside of this state and requests that 22 his or her license be sent to the address of assignment or deployment, the county clerk shall mail the license to the licensee 23 24 at the address of assignment or deployment provided in the renewal 25 application. Until November 30, 2018, if a renewal application is 26 submitted by a member of the United States Armed Forces, the United 27 States Armed Forces Reserve, or the Michigan National Guard who is on orders to a duty station outside of this state, the county clerk 28 29 shall mail a receipt to the licensee by first-class mail.

- 1 (5) (6)—If an individual applies for a renewal license before
 2 the expiration of his or her the individual's license, the
 3 expiration date of the current license is extended until the
 4 renewal license or notice of statutory disqualification is issued.
 5 The county clerk shall notify the department of state police in a
- 6 manner prescribed by the department of state police after he or she
- 7 the county clerk receives an application for renewal. The
- 8 department of state police shall immediately enter into the law
- 9 enforcement information network the date that application for
- 10 renewal was submitted and that the renewal application is pending.
- 11 (6) (7) A person An individual carrying a concealed pistol
 12 after the expiration date of his or her the individual's license
 13 under an extension under subsection (6) (5) shall keep the receipt
 14 issued by the county clerk under subsection (3) and his or her the
 15 individual's expired license in his or her the individual's
- 16 possession at all times that he or she the individual is carrying
- 17 the pistol. For the purposes of this act, the receipt is considered
- 18 to be part of the license to carry a concealed pistol until a
- 19 renewal license is issued or denied or a notice of statutory
- 20 disqualification is issued.
- (7) (8) The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c)
 are waived for an applicant who is a retired police officer or
 retired law enforcement officer.
- (8) (9)—The educational requirements under section 5b(7)(c)

 25 for an applicant who is applying for a renewal of a license under

 26 this act are waived except that the applicant shall certify that he

 27 or she—the applicant has completed at least 3 hours' review of the

 28 training described under section 5b(7)(c) and has had at least 1

 29 hour of firing range time in the 6 months immediately preceding the

- 1 subsequent application. The educational and firing range
- 2 requirements of this subsection are met if the applicant certifies
- ${f 3}$ on the renewal application form that ${f he}$ or she the applicant has
- 4 complied with the requirements of this subsection. An applicant is
- 5 not required to verify the statements made under this subsection
- 6 and is not required to obtain a certificate or undergo training
- 7 other than as required by this subsection.
- 8 (9) (10) An applicant who is applying for a renewal of a
- 9 license issued under section 5b is not required to have
- 10 fingerprints taken again under section 5b(9) if all of the
- 11 following conditions have been met:
- 12 (a) There has been established a system for the department of
- 13 state police to save and maintain in its automated fingerprint
- 14 identification system (AFIS) database all fingerprints that are
- 15 submitted to the department of state police under section 5b.
- 16 (b) The applicant's fingerprints have been submitted to and
- 17 maintained by the department of state police as described in
- 18 subdivision (a) for ongoing comparison with the automated
- 19 fingerprint identification system (AFIS) database.
