## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 556. (1) Any—An employer of labor in this state,

  employing both males and females, who—shall not discriminate in any

  way—in the payment of wages as—between individuals of different
- 4 sexes, religions, races, colors, national origins, ages, heights,
- 5 weights, marital statuses, or other characteristics or attributes

- 3 (2) A person that violates this section is guilty of a
