A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act,"

by amending section 451a (MCL 18.1451a), as added by 1999 PA 8.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 451a. (1) Except as provided in section 248, a work
- 2 project appropriation continues to be available until completion of
- 3 the work or 48-24 months after the last day of the fiscal year in
- 4 which the appropriation was originally made, whichever comes first,
- 5 then the remaining balance lapses to the state fund from which it

- 1 was appropriated. For work projects established before the
- 2 effective date of the amendatory act that added this section, the
- 3 48-month time period described in this subsection begins on the
- 4 last day of the fiscal year in the year the amendatory act that
- 5 added this section takes effect. To be designated as a work project
- 6 on or after the effective date of the amendatory act that added
- 7 subdivision (e), a work project shall must meet all of the
- 8 following criteria:
- 9 (a) The work project shall be Be for a specific purpose.
- 10 (b) The work project shall contain Contain a specific plan to
 11 accomplish its objective.
- 12 (c) The work project shall have Have an estimated completion
- **13** cost.
- 14 (d) The work project shall have Have an estimated completion
- **15** date.
- 16 (e) Have been approved by the appropriations committees. For
- 17 purposes of this subdivision, the appropriations committees shall
- 18 approve or deny a work project submitted to the committee by not
- 19 later than 30 days after the submission is received.
- 20 (2) The director has the authority to may issue directives to
- 21 lapse existing work project accounts at any time. The director
- 22 shall notify each member of the senate and house appropriations
- 23 committees and the fiscal agencies of work projects that the
- 24 director has ordered to lapse. These directives may be disapproved
- 25 by either the senate or house appropriations committee within A
- 26 directive is not effective unless, not later than 30 days after the
- 27 date of notification, and, if disapproved within that time, shall

- 23 designated work projects and the name and description of the work

- 25 (d) The funds that received these lapses.
- 26 (5) If the appropriations committees determine that either of
- 27 the following conditions applies to funds designated as a work
- 28 project, the entity to which the funds were appropriated shall not
- 29 spend or otherwise distribute any of the funds or shall immediately

- 1 cease spending or otherwise distributing the funds, as applicable:
- 2 (a) The entity spent or otherwise distributed the funds for a
- 3 purpose other than the purpose for which the funds were
- 4 appropriated.
- 5 (b) The entity did not or has not spent or otherwise
- 6 distributed the funds in a timely manner.
