

## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 108

Reps. Prestin, Alexander, Breen, Fox, Glanville, Longjohn, MacDonell, Morgan, Outman, Paiz, Rheingans, Rogers and Witwer offered the following resolution:

1           A resolution to declare May 18-24, 2025, as Emergency Medical  
2 Services Week in the state of Michigan.

3           Whereas, Emergency medical services is a vital public service;  
4 and

5           Whereas, The members of emergency medical services teams are  
6 ready to provide lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours a day,  
7 seven days a week; and

8           Whereas, Access to quality emergency care dramatically  
9 improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience  
10 sudden illness or injury; and

11           Whereas, Emergency medical services has grown to fill a gap by  
12 providing important, out-of-hospital care, including preventative

1 medicine, follow-up care, and access to telemedicine; and

2       Whereas, The emergency medical services system consists of  
3 first responders, emergency medical technicians, paramedics,  
4 emergency medical dispatchers, firefighters, police officers,  
5 educators, administrators, pre-hospital nurses, emergency nurses,  
6 emergency physicians, trained members of the public, and other out-  
7 of-hospital medical care providers; and

8       Whereas, The members of emergency medical services teams,  
9 whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of  
10 specialized training and continuing education to enhance their  
11 lifesaving skills; and

12       Whereas, It is appropriate to recognize the value and the  
13 accomplishments of emergency medical services providers by  
14 designating the Emergency Medical Services Week; now, therefore, be  
15 it

16       Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of  
17 this legislative body declare May 18-24, 2025, as Emergency Medical  
18 Services Week in the state of Michigan. We encourage communities  
19 across the state to observe this week with appropriate programs,  
20 ceremonies, and activities.
