## UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE (EXCERPT) Act 174 of 1962

## 440.9341 Bank's rights and duties with respect to deposit account.

Sec. 9341.

Except as otherwise provided in section 9340(3), and unless the bank otherwise agrees in an authenticated record, a bank's rights and duties with respect to a deposit account maintained with the bank are not terminated, suspended, or modified by 1 or more of the following:

- (a) The creation, attachment, or perfection of a security interest in the deposit account.
- (b) The bank's knowledge of the security interest.
- (c) The bank's receipt of instructions from the secured party.
