450.2821 Action by attorney general for dissolution of corporation; grounds; other actions.

Sec. 821.

- (1) The attorney general may bring an action in the circuit court for the county in which the principal place of business or registered office of a corporation is located or for Ingham county for dissolution of a corporation on the ground that the corporation has committed any of the following acts:
 - (a) Procured its organization through fraud.
 - (b) Repeatedly, willfully, and materially exceeded the authority conferred on it by law.
 - (c) Repeatedly, willfully, and materially conducted its affairs in an unlawful manner.
- (2) The enumeration in this section of grounds for dissolution does not exclude any other statutory or common law action by the attorney general for dissolution of a corporation or revocation or forfeiture of its corporate franchises.
